

■ Services

1. NMBPD Average Response Time - 3.8 minutes.
 2. City is divided into six patrol zones.
 3. There are three separate shifts (day shift, afternoon shift and midnight shift).
 4. There is one uniform patrol officer assigned to each patrol zone on each of the shifts. The uniform patrol officers are also supplemented by other specialty unit personnel and as many as twelve officers can be patrolling our streets at any one time.

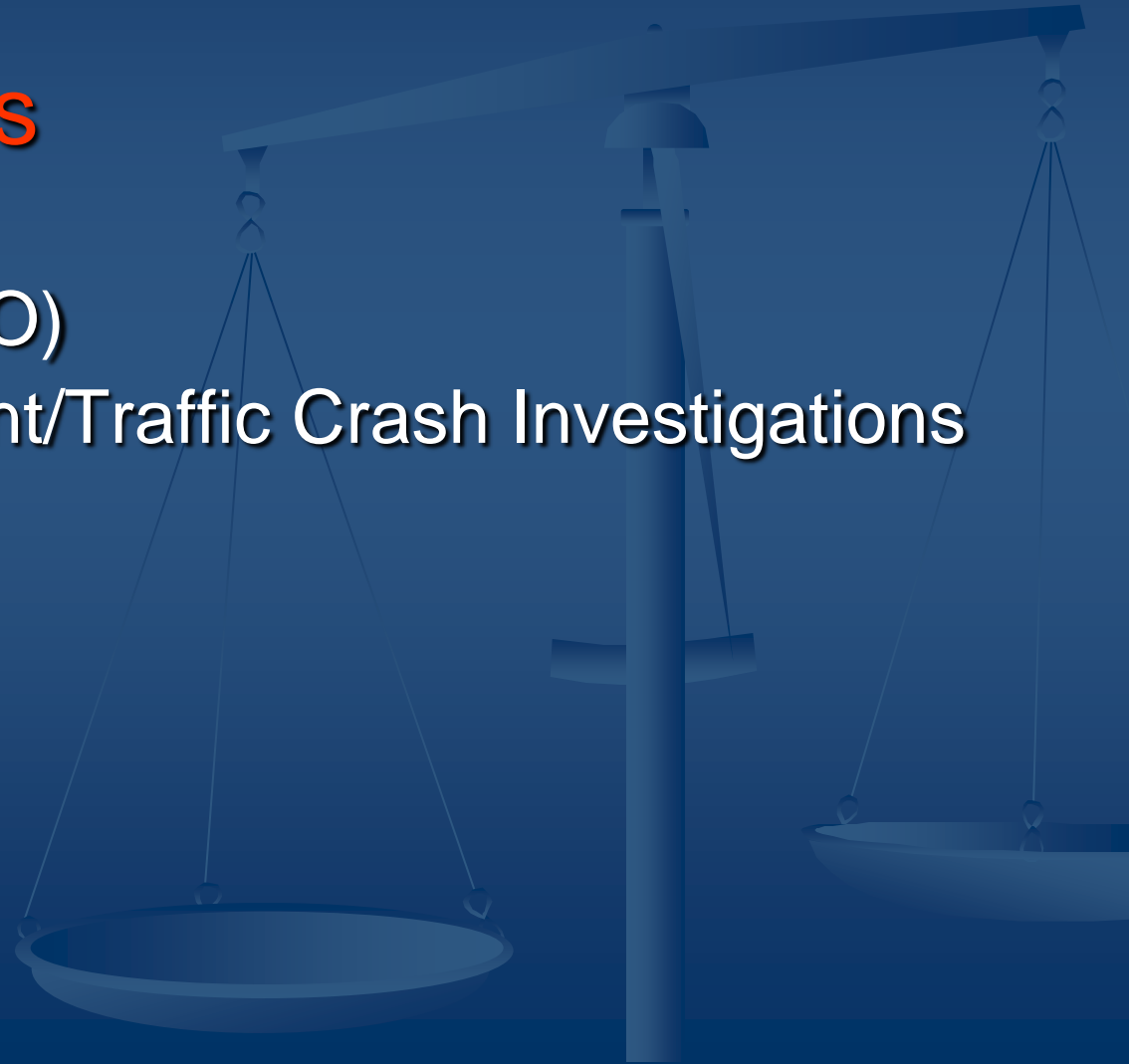

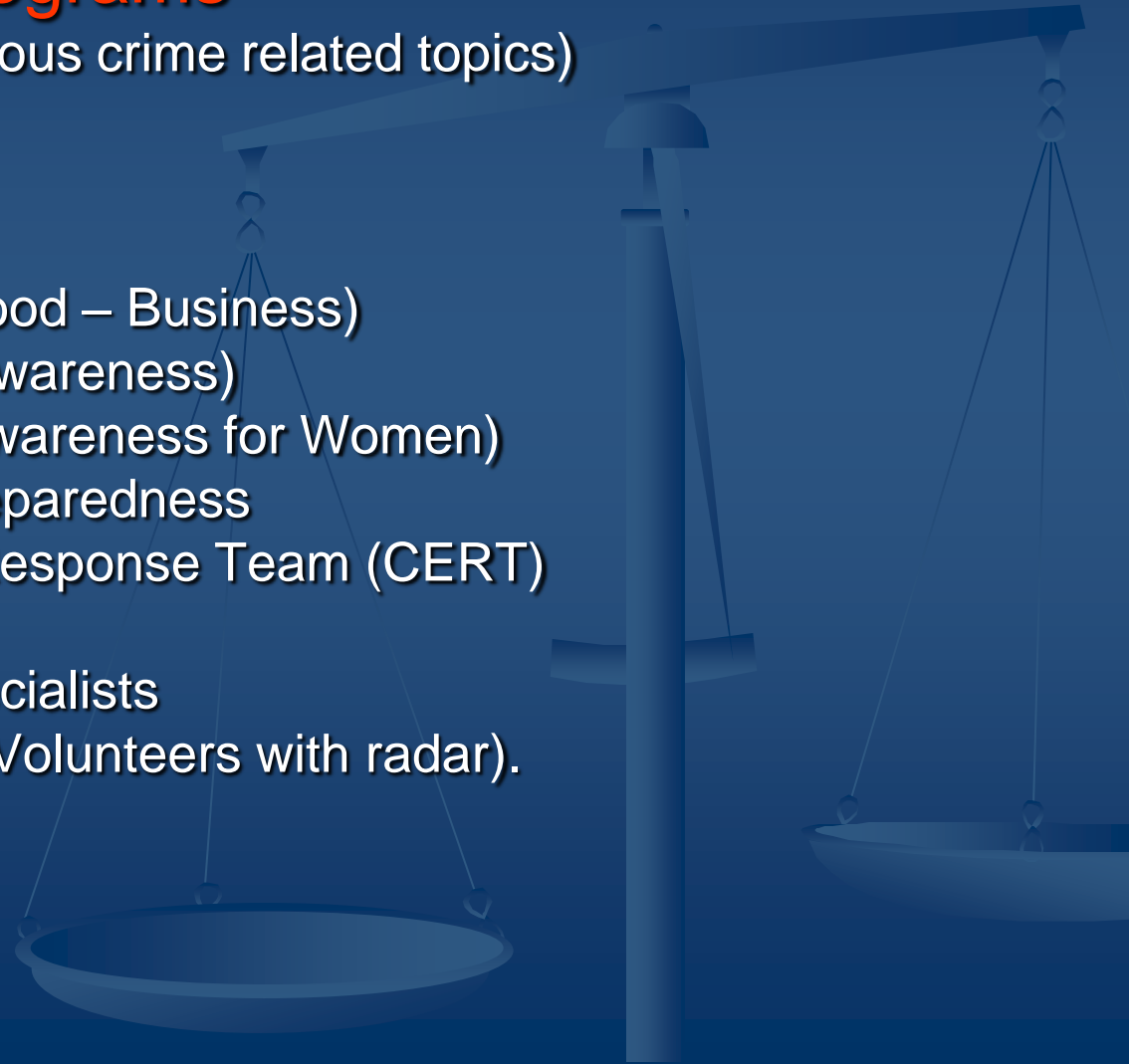

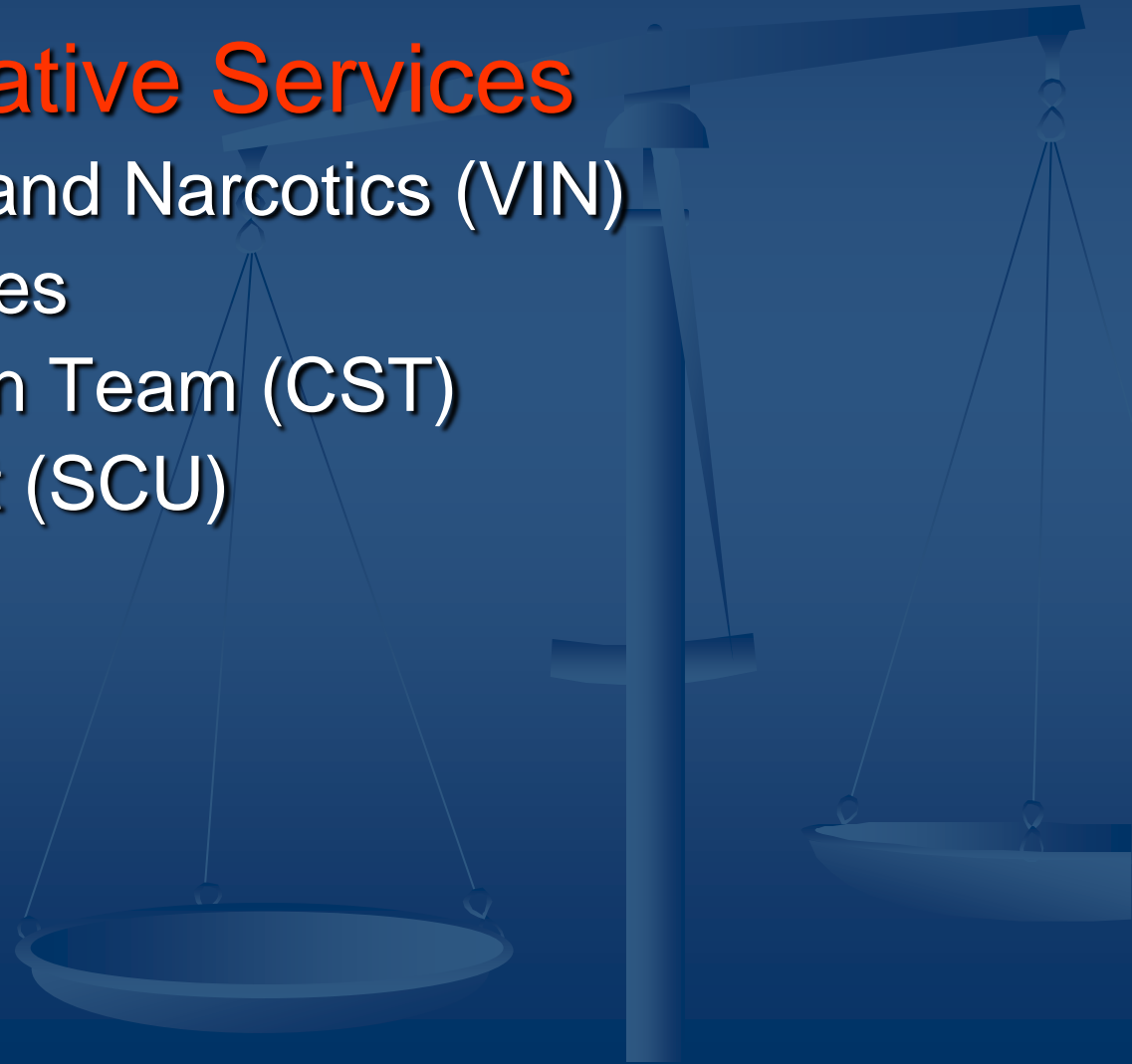

- Neighborhood Services and Inspections – Specialized team of Crime Prevention, Community Policing and Code Enforcement officers primarily addressing quality of life issues.

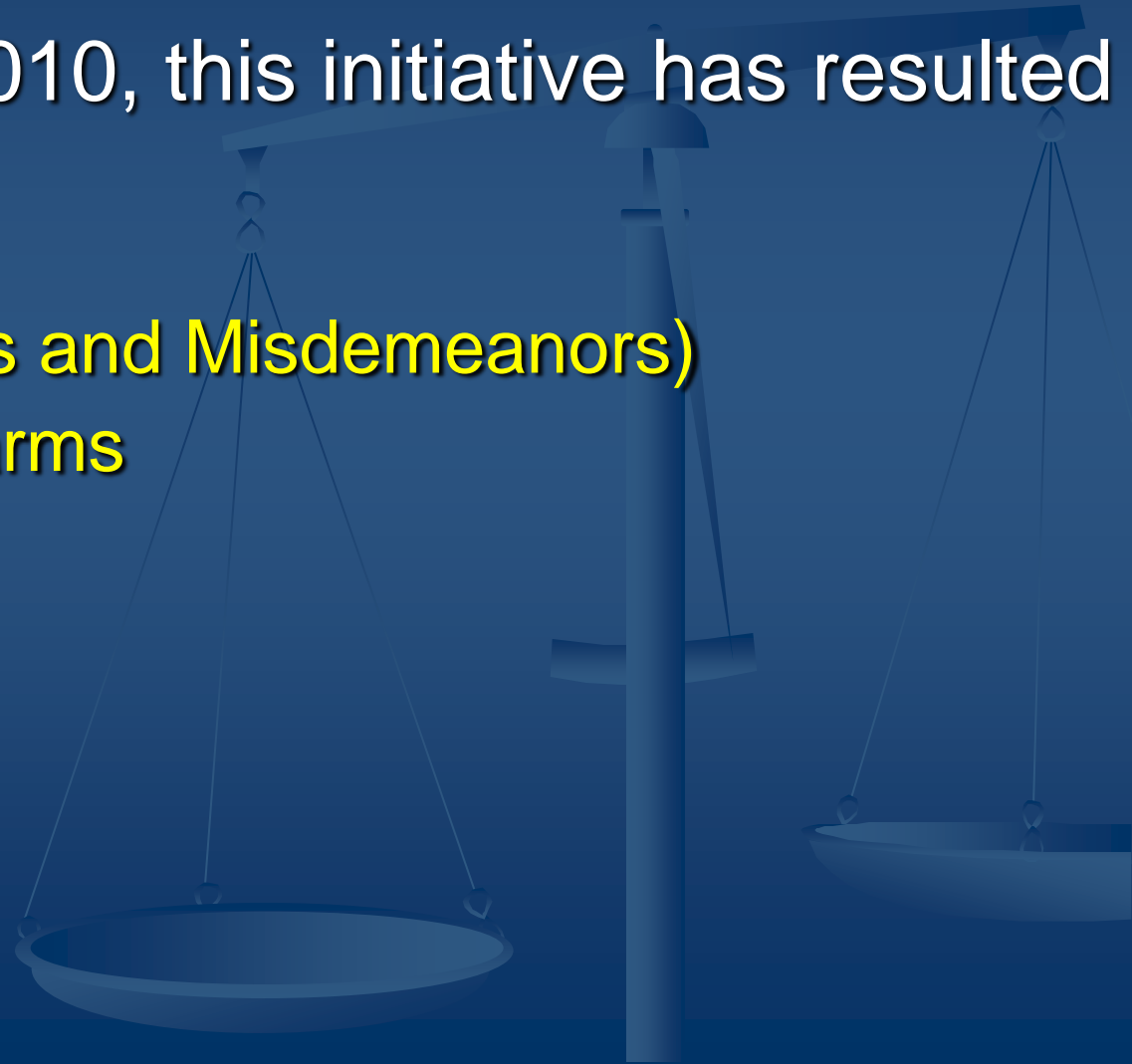
North Miami Beach Police Department Operation Wolf Pack




Mission Statement
